3. Passionate Discipleship (Mt 28:19-20, Jn 1:43, Ps 42:1-2)
4. Loving and Evangelistic Relationships (Mt 22:37-40, Jn 13:34, Acts 1:8, Mt 28:10-20)
5. Empowering Leadership (Mk 6:6b-13, 2 Tim 2:2)

Redeemer's Mission – the 4 E's - reflecting Christ's purpose for his church

Church of the Redeemer exists to exalt Christ firstⁱ through evangelizing the lostⁱⁱ with the gospel of graceⁱⁱⁱ, equipping the saints^{iv} to live gospel-centered lives^v, engaging the culture^{vi} and world around us with mercy^{vii} and mission^{viii} so that people will be redeemed^{ix} and God will be glorified.^x

Redeemer's 3 year Vision – painting a hopeful picture on what we will focus our ministry efforts

Relying on the Spirit and guided by the Gospel, Church of the Redeemer aspires to be a diverse and highly relational community of believers, settled in a permanent facility and growing Christ's church by intentional outreach, proactive discipleship and increased small groups, so more broken neighbors here and around the world would know Christ and would celebrate his salvation and glory together with us.
